Dear Parents/Guardians:

Did you know that students learn better when they eat a nutritious breakfast each day? Studies have shown that test scores go up and behavior problems go down when students eat a good breakfast. Bethlehem Area School District and Aramark have worked together to develop a breakfast program that gets students off to a good start each morning.

Breakfast is offered at all schools throughout the district. The price of a student breakfast is \$1.75 for grades K -5 and \$1.85 for grades 6-12. Students who are approved for reduced price breakfast will pay \$.30. Students who are free eligible may receive breakfast at no charge.

Breakfast in the Classroom is offered in 9 schools. Those schools include Clearview, Donegan, Fountain Hill, Freemansburg, James Buchanan, Lincoln, Marvine, Thomas Jefferson and William Penn. Students at these schools will have the ability to eat their breakfast in class first thing in the morning. The remaining schools serve breakfast in the cafeteria before the first bell. Definitely a great way to start the day!

If you **DO NOT** wish for your child to receive breakfast, please complete the slip below and send back to your school with your child. You can also contact Dining Services directly to ensure your child does **NOT** receive breakfast. If you do not return the slip to school and your child selects a breakfast your child's meal account will be charged the breakfast price according to their meal status.
