**Close Contact through Proximity and Duration of Exposure:** Someone who was within 6 feet of an infected a clinically compatible minutes or more (for An SARS-CoV-2 starting any symptoms (or, for before the positive they meet criteria for

students correctly and consistently wore well-fitting masks the entire time.

This exception does not apply to teachers, staff, or other adults in the indoor classroom setting.
